ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 14, 2012, Plaintiff filed a “Motion to Continue on the Inactive Calendar”.

The Court makes note of the following:

- Plaintiff filed its original Complaint on June 15, 2011.
- On November 16, 2011, the Court placed this case on the inactive calendar for dismissal on **May 10, 2012**.
- On March 5, 2012, Plaintiff filed a “Motion to Continue on the Inactive Calendar”. Through this motion, Plaintiff brought to the Court’s attention the fact that Defendant had filed a bankruptcy petition on September 12, 2011. Given all of the circumstances, the Court continued the case on the inactive calendar until **September 1, 2012**.
- On August 9, 2012, Plaintiff filed another “Motion to Continue on the Inactive Calendar”. Through a minute entry dated September 10, 2012, the Court

continued the case on the inactive calendar until **January 11, 2013**. Through the same minute entry, the Court warned that this case would be dismissed if certain action was not taken before that date.

- The action required by the Court's minute entry of September 10, 2012, has not been taken.

**IT IS ORDERED** denying the "Motion to Continue on the Inactive Calendar" filed by Plaintiff on December 14, 2012. Further,

**IT IS ORDERED** dismissing this case off of the inactive calendar.
