MINUTE ENTRY

On January 14, 2014, the Court denied the Acacia Homeowner's Association Application ("AHOA") for reasonable attorneys because it mistakenly believed there was no *China Doll* affidavit. The Court previously entered an order granting the AHOA its reasonable attorney's fees. Having now reviewed the application and the *China Doll* Affidavit,

IT IS ORDERED that the Maricopa County Treasurer shall disburse \$1000 by and for reasonable attorney's fees, pursuant to Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 33-821(I) out of the excess proceeds.

ALERT: The Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2011-140 directs the Clerk's Office not to accept paper filings from attorneys in civil cases. Civil cases must still be initiated on paper; however, subsequent documents must be eFiled through AZTurboCourt unless an exception defined in the Administrative Order applies.
