clerk or from the Self Service Center to request a daily copy of a court hearing or trial proceeding being conducted. Pay the applicable fee **at the Self Service Center**. Attach the receipt showing payment of the fee and present both the receipt and the form to the bailiff. **For copies of hearings or trial proceedings recorded previously, please call Electronic Records Services at 602-506-7100.** Should an official transcript be required, you may request that the court prepare it. The party ordering the transcript must pay for it. To request a transcript, call 602-506-7100 and provide the date of the proceeding, the case number, the case caption, if the transcript is for an appeal, and your name, address, and telephone number.

With this new technology, a court reporter is likely not required and the parties are encouraged to experience the court's video recording system before requesting a court reporter. Pursuant to Local Rule 2.22, if a party desires a court reporter for any proceeding in which a court reporter is not mandated by Arizona Supreme Court Rule 30, the party must submit a written request to the assigned judicial officer at least ten (10) judicial days in advance of the hearing, and must pay the authorized fee to the Clerk of the Court at least two (2) judicial days before the proceeding. The fee is \$140 for a half-day and \$280 for a full day.

PLEASE NOTE: This division requires that all motions, responses, replies and other Court requested filings in this case must be submitted individually. Counsel shall not combine any motion with a responsive pleading. All motions are to be filed separately and designated as such. No pleadings will be accepted if filed in combination with another.

PLEASE NOTE: Effective June 26, 2017, all cases assigned to Judge Joshua D. Rogers, will be re-assigned to Judge Sherry K. Stephens due to judicial calendar rotations.
