MINUTE ENTRY

Before the Court is the parties' Joint Status Memorandum. Following the settlement conference with Judge McCoy, the parties should submit a Joint Report and Proposed Scheduling Order with a plan for promptly bringing this matter to resolution. The Joint Report should specifically address whether the parties are requesting and have the right to a jury trial.

IT IS ORDERED that a Joint Report and Proposed Scheduling Order be filed **no later than July 6, 2021.**

at all times they are in the Court facility. With limited exceptions, the Court will not provide masks or face coverings. Therefore, any individual attempting to enter the Court facility must have an appropriate mask or face covering to be allowed entry to the Court facility. Any person who refuses to wear a mask or face covering as directed will be denied entrance to the Court facility or asked to leave. In addition, all individuals entering a Court facility will be subject to a health screening protocol. Any person who does not pass the health screening protocol will be denied entrance to the Court facility.
