**NOTE:** All court proceedings are recorded digitally and not by a court reporter. Pursuant to Local Rule 2.22, if a party desires a court reporter for any proceeding in which a court reporter is not mandated by Arizona Supreme Court Rule 30, the party must submit a written request to the assigned judicial officer at least ten (10) judicial days in advance of the hearing, and must pay the authorized fee to the Clerk of the Court at least two (2) judicial days before the proceeding. The fee is \$140 for a half-day and \$280 for a full day.

If the parties are not familiar with the courtroom's technology, they are encouraged to set up an appointment with the court's technology liaison at (602) 506-3269.

Pursuant to the Declaration of Emergency \*COVID19\* issued by Governor Ducey on March 11, 2020, and consistent with Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2020-114 issued on July 15, 2020, and Amended Administrative Order 2020-078 issued by Joseph C. Welty, Presiding Judge of this Court, on May 29, 2020, the proceeding is being conducted electronically using the *Court Connect* virtual audio-video platform. All participants, including the parties, their lawyers, and the witnesses, are appearing electronically.
