MINUTE ENTRY

Addendum To Minute Entry of 02/15/2023.

1. **MOTIONS IN LIMINE.** All Motions in Limine shall be filed no later than **5:00 p.m. on July 18, 2023** and such motions must meet the test of *State v. Superior Court*, 108 Ariz. 396, 397; 499 P.2d 152 (1972): The primary purpose of a Motion in Limine is to avoid disclosing to the jury prejudicial matters which may compel a mistrial. See also, Ariz. R. Evid. 103(d). Any written Response to a Motion in Limine shall be filed no later than **5:00 p.m. on July 28, 2023**. The Court may rule on Motions in Limine without oral argument. No Replies shall be filed. Prior to filing a Motion in Limine, the parties are to confer and attempt to resolve those issues. The parties shall further certify to the Court the efforts made to resolve those issues before filing a Motion in Limine. The parties must comply with Rule 7.2(a) Ariz.R.Civ.P., prior to filing any Motion in Limine. Any Motion in Limine filed without the movant having first complied with Rule 7.2(a), will be stricken by the Court. The parties are limited to only filing three Motions in limine.
2. **Joint Pre-Trial Statement.** The due date for the Joint Pre-Trial Statement is accelerated to **August 1, 2023 by 5:00 p.m.**
