RULING

The Court has considered Plaintiff's Motion to Have the Allegations of the Complaint Be Taken as Confessed Pursuant to Rule 11(c), Defendant's Response to Motion to Have Allegations of the Complaint Taken as Confessed as well as Plaintiff's Reply thereto.

Oral argument has been requested. However, the parties have thoroughly briefed their respective positions, and the Court deems oral argument unnecessary for a determination of the issue. The request for oral argument is denied.

For the reasons stated by Defendant,

IT IS ORDERED denying Plaintiff's Motion to Have the Allegations of the Complaint Be Taken as Confessed Pursuant to Rule 11(c).
