The Court has considered Plaintiff's June 23, 2017 Motion for Reconsideration (hereafter referred to as the "Motion for Reconsideration") of the Court's June 20, 2017 Minute Entry ruling with regard to Plaintiff's June 12, 2017 Motion for Alternative Service (hereafter referred to as the "Motion").

Good cause appearing,
