The Court notes that Plaintiff's Notice of Errata was filed June 23, 2018, concerning CPA John Griffin; and Defendant's Objection to "Notice of Errata" and Motion to Strike was filed on July 3, 2018.

Argument is held on Plaintiff's Motion in Limine re Defense Trial Exhibits, filed on June 28, 2018.

**LET THE RECORD REFLECT** that the Court made its ruling on the record.

Due to the complex nature of each of Defendants' exhibits, Plaintiff may challenge the admissibility of them; and the Court will rule on the admissibility of each exhibit at trial, subject to the parties laying proper foundation.

Any exhibits that were marked for identification that were intended to be used for impeachment purposes will not be ruled on until the appropriate time. The parties must bring in original documents to add to or replace any exhibits that may have been altered in any way.

**LET THE RECORD REFLECT** that Harinder Chowhan, Hindi Interpreter, that is currently scheduled for three trial dates has informed the Court that he cannot attend trial for all 3 days. Mr. Chowhan is unable to attend trial on July 24, 2018. Accordingly,

**IT IS ORDERED** that the current trial dates of July 23, 2018, July 24, 2018 and July 30, 2018 will be **changed** to: **July 23, 2018; July 27, 2018; and July 30, 2018** to accommodate the translator's schedule. Trial days begin at 9:30 a.m. each day.

**IT IS ORDERED** appointing a Hindi interpreter from Court Interpretation and Translation Services to the case to assist Defendant, Surendra Pala, with all proceedings. The next scheduled proceeding is for three trial days as follows: July 23, 2018; July 27, 2018; and July 30, 2018. Trial days begin at 9:30 a.m. each day.

Argument is heard regarding Plaintiff's Notice of Errata and Motion to Strike, filed on June 23, 2018; and regarding Defendants' Objection to "Notice of Errata" and Motion to Strike on July 3, 2018.
