A formal order in accordance with the above is signed by the Court on August 14, 2013 and filed (entered) by the clerk on August 14, 2013.

All exhibits, if any, shall be exchanged 15 days before the hearing. Counsel shall confer regarding exhibits so duplicates are avoided and list any stipulations to those exhibits which can be received in evidence. Counsel shall present all exhibits with a list of exhibit descriptions to the clerk **no less than ten (10) judicial days before the hearing**. The parties should contact the clerk directly at **(602) 506-0984** to discuss procedures for marking exhibits.

IT IS ORDERED that all motions, responses, replies and other Court requested filings in this case must be submitted individually. **Counsel shall not combine any motion with a responsive pleading.** All motions are to be filed separately and designated as such. No pleadings will be accepted if filed in combination with another.

NOTE: All Court proceedings are recorded by audio method and not by a court reporter. Any party may request the presence of a court reporter by contacting the division three (3) court business days before the scheduled hearing.

ALERT: The Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2011-140 directs the Clerk's Office not to accept paper filings from attorneys in civil cases. Civil cases must still be initiated on paper; however, subsequent documents must be eFiled through AZTurboCourt unless an exception defined in the Administrative Order applies.
