IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Defendants' counsel shall initiate the telephonic conference by first arranging the presence of all other counsel or self-represented parties on the conference call and then calling this division (602.506.2194) promptly at the scheduled time. All parties appearing telephonically must be joined in a single conference call and be prepared to hold until called upon.

The call should be placed in an area with no background noise and not in a moving vehicle. Failure to do so may prevent the parties from hearing the proceedings in the courtroom and/or may prevent the Court from hearing the parties. State your name so there may be a clear record as to which party is speaking.

The parties/attorneys are advised that failure to appear telephonically for the hearing may result in sanctions, including dismissal of the action per Rule 16(F), Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure.

All court proceedings are recorded by audio and video method and not by a court reporter. Pursuant to Local Rule 2.22, if a party desires a court reporter for any proceeding in which a court reporter is not mandated by Arizona Supreme Court Rule 30, the party must submit a written request to the assigned judicial officer at least ten (10) judicial days in advance of the hearing and must pay the authorized fee to the Clerk of the Court at least two (2) judicial days before the proceeding. The fee is \$140 for a half day and \$280 for a full day.

PLEASE NOTE: If/when a party files a pleading within 48 hours of a scheduled event the party also should email same to the Court's judicial assistant at gomezr002@superiorcourt.maricopa.gov and to the Court's bailiff at dellergof@superiorcourt.maricopa.gov.

COUNSEL SHALL UPLOAD AND E-FILE ALL PROPOSED ORDERS IN WORD FORMAT ONLY TO ALLOW FOR POSSIBLE MODIFICATION BY THE COURT.
