TELEPHONIC PRETRIAL STATUS/SCHEDULING CONFERENCE SET

The Court has received and reviewed the parties' Stipulation to Continue Pretrial Deadlines.

IT IS ORDERED that the parties shall submit a joint pretrial memorandum as set forth below.

If the parties fail to file a timely memorandum, sanctions may issue pursuant to Rule 16(f).

IT IS ORDERED:

All counsel are directed to meet personally to discuss all of the matters set forth in Rule 16(b). Counsel shall prepare and file with the Court by **5:00 p.m. November 12, 2007**, a joint pretrial memorandum, and prepare a proposed schedule for discovery and disclosure deadlines. The proposed schedule shall include dates for the following items:

- 1. A date for the disclosure of subject areas of expert testimony.**

2. **A date for the disclosure of the identities and opinions of expert witnesses** (e.g., Plaintiff(s) disclosure deadline, Defendant(s) disclosure deadline and Plaintiff(s) rebuttal experts deadlines, if applicable).
3. **A date for disclosure of all non-expert witnesses.**
4. **A date for the completion of all discovery.** As far as can reasonably be anticipated, each party shall set forth the depositions they anticipate taking and the approximate time required for each; any and all medical examinations which may be required of any of the parties; the person or persons to conduct such examinations; all requests for production; and all tangible evidence to be disclosed or exchanged.
5. **A date by which all dispositive or partially-dispositive motions shall be filed.**

NOTE: All discovery and/or dispositive motions/partially dispositive motions will be filed as individual and separate pleadings. Counsel shall *not* file any dispositive motions as cross-motions or by way of a response or reply to a dispositive motion.
6. **A proposed deadline for a private mediation or mandatory settlement conference pursuant to Rule 16.1.**
7. **The position of each counsel on whether Rule 38.1 time limits should be waived.**
8. **Anticipated length of trial.**

If counsel are unable to agree on any of the preceding items, the reasons for their inability to agree shall be set forth in the pretrial memorandum and each shall prepare a separate proposed memorandum. **All proposed deadlines shall be set forth as calendar dates, and not in the form "XX days before trial."**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that counsel shall notify the Court of any agreed-upon extension of any time period provided by the Rules of Civil Procedure. The purpose of this order is not to discourage extensions as a matter of professionalism, but to ensure that no party suffers summary disposition of any issue by virtue of an extension of which the Court is not aware.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED setting a Telephonic Status Conference in this matter on **November 19, 2007 at 10:00 a.m.**, (time allotted: 15 minutes), in this Division.
