2. Attaching/posting a copy of the Summons, Complaint, this Order, and any other paper filed with the Complaint to the front door of Defendant's last known residential dwelling;

3. Mailing a copy of the Summons, Complaint, this Order, and any other paper filed with the Complaint via the U.S. Postal Service at the Defendant's place of employment, if known.

Defendant is advised that he must answer the Complaint in this matter within the time mandated by the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure once service is accomplished as set forth in this Order. Failure to so answer may result in the entry of a default judgment.
