- (2) File a notice of lodging and lodge an appropriate form of order for release of the proceeds.

If there exists any apparent lien, encumbrance, or interest that could have priority over Applicants, Applicants shall acknowledge the existence of such lien, encumbrance, or interest either in the Application or in a subsequent filing mailed to all persons who have received a copy of the complaint or filed a responsive pleading. If a lien, encumbrance, or interest may exist, the Court will not enter an order directing the Treasurer to release the proceeds until 180 days from the date on which the Complaint was filed. *See* A.R.S. § 33- 812(J).
