Plaintiff Camboni has clearly been advised that Arizona law does not allow him to represent the other Plaintiffs in this case. Still, Plaintiff Camboni continues to claim that he represents the other Plaintiffs. For example, on October 15, 2014, Plaintiff Camboni filed regarding his address a "Notice of Change of Address". Among other things, in the pending "Motion for Enlargement", Plaintiff Camboni suggests that Defendants must send copies of pleadings to the other Plaintiffs through Plaintiff Camboni at his current address.
