Counsel for Plaintiff shall initiate the conference call by calling **(602) 506-4791**. The call should be placed from a telephone in an area with no background noise as this will prevent the parties from hearing the proceedings. The call may not be placed from a vehicle. Also, the use of cellular telephones and speakerphones is strongly discouraged.

This is a **15 minute proceeding**. The Court will determine if more time is needed. If there is a failure to appear, the Court may make such orders as are just, including granting the relief requested by the party who does appear.

NOTE: All court proceedings are recorded digitally and not by a court reporter. Pursuant to Local Rule 2.22, if a party desires a court reporter for any proceeding in which a court reporter is not mandated by Arizona Supreme Court Rule 30, the party must submit a written request to the assigned judicial officer at least ten (10) judicial days in advance of the hearing, and must pay the authorized fee to the Clerk of the Court at least two (2) judicial days before the proceeding. The fee is \$140 for a half-day and \$280 for a full day.
