This Courtroom uses an electronic recording system for the record. All CDs and videotapes will be provided by the Court, regardless of when the copies are made. Upon payment of the appropriate fees through the Self-Service Center, a receipt will be issued which shall then be presented to Court staff for preparation of the CD or videotape in the customary manner.
